A Pet for Christmas? Think Again

What could be cuter than a puppy or kitten under the Christmas tree? Not much, perhaps, but according to many veterinarians, breed clubs, and rescue organizations (including us!), there are several good reasons not to purchase or adopt an animal as a Christmas gift.

First of all, there's the "fear factor." A new pet may be leaving the security of its mother and littermates for the first time—a pretty major transition. To be successful, this transition must involve the establishment of a routine and constant positive attention from, and interaction with, the animal's new "pack."

This can be difficult during the hubbub of the holiday season, with its loud noises, blinking lights, ringing phones, and visiting friends and family. Keeping a curious puppy or kitten safe from harmful decorations, plants, foods, etc. that may cause injury or illness can also be more difficult during the hectic holidays.

And no matter how much children have pestered, an animal under the tree isn't the best idea for them either. They need to learn that this cute, fuzzy little creature isn't just another "thing" to enjoy and then discard when they're bored. Rather, it is a bona fide member of the family with needs of its own—needs that will endure long after the holiday decorations are taken

down and stored away. For these reasons, good breeders won't sell Christmas pets and many rescue organizations won't adopt during the holiday season.

Rather than a live animal, create a special holiday surprise with the promise of a pet after the holidays. Any of the following items under the tree will help build a sense of anticipation and excitement:

- A picture of a puppy or kitten;
- A stuffed animal in a pet bed or a crate;
- Books on dog breeds and their characteristics or on cat care;
